COLD WEATHER UNIFORM REMINDERS- We have several uniform options for students when the weather turns cold. Boys and Girls can wear St. Aloysius sweatpants, sweatshirts, navy uniform sweater, the navy blue uniform jacket, or the navy uniform fleece. Other jackets/coats may be worn outside only. Girls have the option to wear white, navy, or black tights **or** leggings under their uniform. They can also wear a long sleeve white turtleneck or long

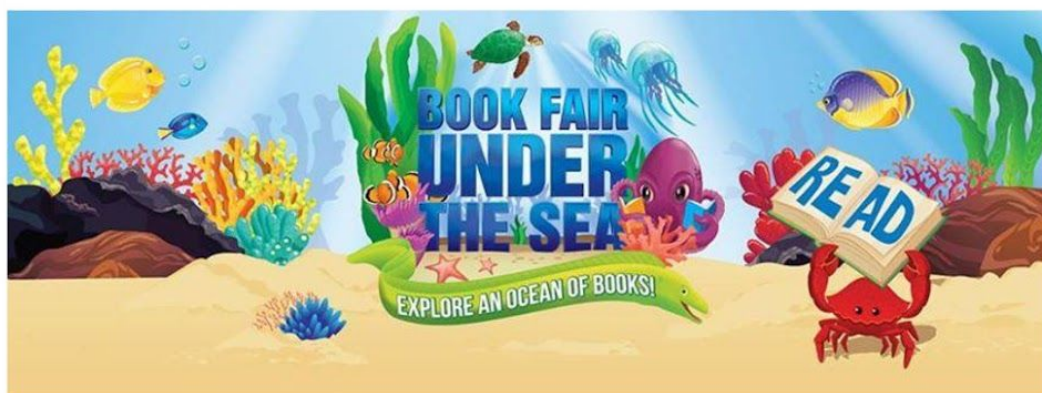
