INFECTION PREVENTION PLAN & PROCEDURES 2021-2022

FACE COVERINGS

- All faculty and students are highly encouraged but not required to bring a face covering (labeled with name) to wear indoors.

ARRIVAL

- Prior to arrival, parents are encouraged to complete the daily home screening for students; it is available under important links on the website. Sending a child to school confirms that each child is in good health.
- Traditional SAS carpool procedures will be followed.
- Students will report to their designated area in order to provide social distancing upon arrival.
- No one is allowed to walk children onto campus, even from St. Aloysius Childcare Center.
- Students will use hand sanitizer upon entry to the classroom.
- Buses are allowed to operate at 100% capacity. All passengers on the school bus must wear face coverings while using transportation, regardless of capacity.

DISMISSAL

- Traditional SAS carpool procedures will be followed.

LATE CHECK-IN

- All late arrivals will check-in inside the main office on the computer stations with disinfection protocols in place.

CHECK-OUT

- Parent arrives and requests child(ren) to check-out.
- Student(s) is called to the office while the parent waits inside the office for the child(ren).

CLASSROOM

- Student desks will be spaced to the maximum extent possible to allow for social distancing.
- Supplies will be shared and disinfected regularly.
- Students must bring a water bottle as water fountains will be closed.

INSTRUCTIONAL TRAFFIC & ENRICHMENT

- Grades 4-8 will switch classes.
- Enrichment classes will take place in regular locations.

LUNCH

- Students will eat in a combination of cafeteria, classrooms, and outside.
- Staggered dismissal will minimize congestion in hallways.

RECESS

- Grade level recess.
- Large group gatherings (such as morning assembly) will be minimized until after Labor Day.

MASS

GATHERINGS

- Students will attend grade level mass with social distancing guidelines in place.
- Students will attend all-school mass.
- Field trips will be scheduled for late Fall.

VOLUNTEERS

- Limited visitors including volunteers & therapists are allowed on campus.
- All visitors will be screened prior to entry by the school nurse and will be encouraged to wear a face covering.
- If a parent must enter campus for any reason, a face covering is encouraged.

ISOLATION & NOTIFICATION

- In the event a student presents symptoms during the school day, the student will be relocated to a separate area, apart from other students, until a parent or guardian arrives to pick them up.
- Families will be notified and a plan implemented if a risk to students is determined. Medical experts will be consulted.
