<u>TUITION</u> - Tuition is due <u>Tuesday, May 4, 2021</u>. Payment must be made through Gulf Coast Bank via E-Check (*Non-financing option*). (https://tuition.gulfbank.com). If financing through the Gulf Coast Tuition Loan Program, loan applications must be submitted by May 4 as well. Current year tuition loans must be closed out in order to apply for a Gulf Coast tuition loan for 2021-22. Any payments or loan applications made after May 4th, will incur a

\$50.00 (PER CHILD) late fee (*payable directly to the school*). Tuition information can be found under **Important Links** on the school website (**Tuition and Fee Information**).
